

In 2018 Dean decided to move home to Scotland. This coincided with Dean feeling it to be the right time to enter MasterChef the professional where he wowed judges from the get-go. ## BURNS NIGHT IN ST ANDREWS TOAST THE HAGGIS WITH A 'WEE DRAM'



"Fair fa' your honest, sonsie face, Great chieftain o' the pudding-race!" The spirited words of Robert Burns' famous 'Address to a Haggis' fill St Andrews as the town gathers to celebrate Scotland's national bard on January 25th. In a night of haggis, whisky, and songs, the Burns Night creates a spirited ode to Scotland's rich cultural heritage and the enduring legacy of Robert Burns.

In 1801, this tradition began in Burns' family home in Alloway with a modest group of Burns' nine closest friends gathering on the fifth anniversary of his death. In subsequent years, informal Burns clubs came together to follow the festivities of the first celebration, although on his birthday instead. The traditions of that night including the food (except the sheep's head) and the poem readings have held up to this day over 200 years later.

The night begins with the host reciting the 'Selkirk Grace' before the feast: "Some hae meat and canna eat / And some wad eat that want it; / But we hae meat, and we can eat, / Sae let the Lord be thankit." After dining on a starter, Scotland's national dish is brought forth on a decorative platter for everyone to stand and see as a piper announces its entrance. Once set down, a brave soul performs the 'Address to Haggis' with dramatic enthusiasm as a ceremonial knife cuts into the sheep's stomach to reveal the haggis—a pudding including the minced liver, heart, and lungs of a sheep along with beef suet, oatmeal, and seasonings. This main course is served with mashed neeps and tatties

(turnips and potatoes) along with the first of many drams.

During the meal, one man will give the 'Toast to the Lassies' which was traditionally used to thank the women for cooking but now has evolved to a humorous speech about women and their influence on men, often catering towards the specific group present. In response, a woman will stand to deliver the 'Reply to the Laddies' and address the previous speech with counterpoints about men. At the end of the first speech all the men collectively toast 'To the Lassies!' and after the second, the women toast 'To the Laddies!'. To conclude the night of laughter and feasting, the host gives the 'Vote of Thanks' and everyone joins together to perform Burns' 'Auld Lang Syne' and express everlasting friendship before drinking into the night.

In St Andrews, anyone can participate in the tradition as restaurants hold special Burns Night events with four-course meals, traditional music, and plenty of whisky. Some places even hold ceilidhs to further celebrate with traditional Scottish dancing. Whether a local or just stopping by Burn's Night creates the perfect environment to socialize and celebrate Scottish heritage through the country's national bard.

An award winning seafood restaurant with casual dining, they also offer event nights like champagne & lobster Reisling or Scottish Gin tasting nights hosted by Luvians bottle shop.

Students can celebrate graduation with bespoke celebratory menus and golfers experience the "traditional fish, chips, mushy peas and tartar sauce" and all the fantastic seafood that Scotland has to offer like local lobsters, langoustines, halibut & hake to name a few!

On a Monday in mid-October, first-year students at the University of St Andrews gather to face off in a massive shaving foam fight. This annual tradition with obscure origins concludes Raisin Weekend, a time filled with bizarre events intended to initiate the new students.

To join in these festivities, freshers must find an academic family. These families form when third-year students get academically married to their close friends, even including proposals and wedding ceremonies. They then become academic parents and mentor first years by 'adopting' them as their children. Leading up to the big weekend new students go to different family events such as dinners or drinking games at their flats before deciding which one to join. Each family operates differently so students can find the right fit for them whether they want a more relaxed or extravagant experience. university and organically transferred through generations of students without university involvement. Throughout this time, there were various editions or modifications, but ultimately it's the students' role to continue the legacy.

Activities start early before sunrise on Sunday. ### ST ANDREWS CASTLE & THE CATHEDRAL

These two sites are steeped in history, caught in the Protestant Reformation struggle for hearts and minds.

St Andrews Cathedral, now ruined, is one of Scotland's largest and most magnificent medieval Churches. The ruins tell a story of grand construction at a time of stylistic change, and the dramatic iconoclasm that followed the reformation. The Cathedral site plays host to history from the time of the Picts through to the present day. St Andrews Castle was a bishop's palace, a fortress and a state prison during its 450-year history. Its size signalled the power and wealth of the important churchmen who resided there in the Middle Ages. Protestant preacher George Wishart may have been imprisoned in the castle's bottle dungeon. Cardinal Beaton's murdered body was certainly



kept in the dank and airless hole. The assassination sparked the brutal siege of 1546–47, when opposing sides dug the remarkable mine and countermine into the rock close to the castle battlements. Visit the exhibition to hear about the darkness of the bottle dungeon and feel the drama of the siege.

St Andrews Castle and Cathedral currently have access restrictions in place due to essential high-level masonry inspections, which are part of Historic Environment Scotland's new approach in response to the effects of climate change on our historic buildings and to ensure public safety at our sites. The visitor centre, exhibition and toilets at the Castle are open More information on the sites and our essential inspections can be found online.



## THE CURSED STONES OF PATRICK HAMILTON

While walking along North Street, it is easy to miss a curious set of stones outside the entrance to St. Salvator's Quadrangle. Yet, the history of this symbol still impacts University of St Andrews students who avoid stepping on the PH or else risk failing their exams.

This haunting tradition and the stones that caused it originate from the death of Patrick Hamilton, the Scottish churchman and Protestant Reformer. In 1523, he moved to St Andrews and worked at the University. However, with inspiration from Martin Luther, Hamilton converted amidst a Roman Catholic Scotland. James Beaton, Archbishop of St Andrews, declared Hamilton's views heretical, forcing him to flee to Germany, but Hamilton returned later that year to preach openly.

Eventually, a council of bishops called Hamilton to trial on account of thirteen charges, all of which Hamilton agreed to believe. After being sentenced to death, Hamilton was burned at the stake—at the PH—where it gruesomely took him six hours to die since the wind kept blowing out the fire.

Now the ground marks Hamilton's legacy. Legend says if you look above the

archway of the PH, you can still see Patrick Hamilton (or the devil's face) glaring down at you, hoping to curse any student who missteps. Luckily, the students still have hope to cleanse their academic sins by running into the freezing waters of West Sands on May Dip—while naked, of course.





St Andrews is known around the world as the Home of Golf, where the game was first played more than 600 years ago and where the game continues to thrive to this day.

golf experience and each one contributing to the illustrious history of the world's

#### THE OLD COURSE

The Old Course is, quite simply, where it all began. To tread the fairways of the Grand Old Lady is to walk in the footsteps of golf legends from every generation, yet the greatest feature of the Old Course is that despite its grand status, it remains a public golf course. Golf has been played here since the 1400's but was made official in 1552 when Archbishop Hamilton signed a charter to recognise the right of the people of St Andrews to play golf on the links.

To this day, the Old Course remains closed on Sundays instead making way for people to walk the fairways as a public park. In its unrivalled history, the Old Course has played host to the game's greatest events including hosting The Open on 30 separate occasions, creating some of the sport's most iconic moments.





#### THE CASTLE

The newest addition to St Andrews Links, The Castle Course, was built in 2008, becoming the seventh course at the Home of Golf and part of the largest public golfing complex in Europe. Set on a rugged cliff top with spectacular views over St Andrews, The Castle Course offers a memorable golfing experience.



#### THE NEW

The oldest 'new' course in the world, the second course at the Home of Golf, was built by the 'Keeper of the Green' Tom Morris, in 1895 and is a classic test of Links golf, offering a first-class experience in its own right.



#### THE JUBILEE

The third championship course at the Home of Golf, the Jubilee, was built in 1897 and named in honour of Queen Victoria's Diamond Jubilee. It is considered by many to be the most challenging course on the famous links

#### THE EDEN

Only slightly more forgiving than its contemporaries on the seaward side of the Links, the Eden Course was built in 1914 by internationally renowned designer Harry S. Colt, whose use of buried natural boundaries and severe bunkers provides a course full of character.



#### THE STRATHTYRUM

Designed to complement the tougher championship layouts at the Home of Golf, the Strathtyrum was opened in 1993. Although few in number (15), the bunkers are cunningly placed, and there is a considerable emphasis on iron play accuracy.



#### THE BALGOVE

The Balgove is the only nine-hole course at the Home of Golf and primarily caters for families, children, and beginners. Featuring bunkers and a double green, the Balgove is the perfect practice-ground for links golf and consolidates St Andrews Links' reputation as a resort that caters for all ages and abilities.

The Dumbarnie Links near Upper Largo was one of the most eagerly anticipated new golf courses to be built not only in Scotland but worldwide.

Since it's opening in 2020 the links has quickly established itself as a rare gift of a design that is equally fair, playable and visually stunning. If you didn't know better you would assume it had been there for hundreds of years.



In 2021 it held the prestigious Woman's Scottish Open and was applauded globally as being a great success for the team including the course architect Clive Clark.

If you get the opportunity to play this fabulous links while in the area, take it! You will be delighted by the on course experience as well as the welcoming service from the Dumbarnie team in their well appointed clubhouse.


